Project Background

- Park site dedicated by developers
- June 2020: City Council approved funding for park design
- Designated construction budget: \$1.5 Million
- July 19, 2022: Community Meeting #1

 - November 2022 - Parks and Recreation Commission
 - January 2023 - City Council
- Design
 - Winter 2023 - Fall 2023 – Construction Documents
- Construction
 - Winter 2024 - Summer 2024

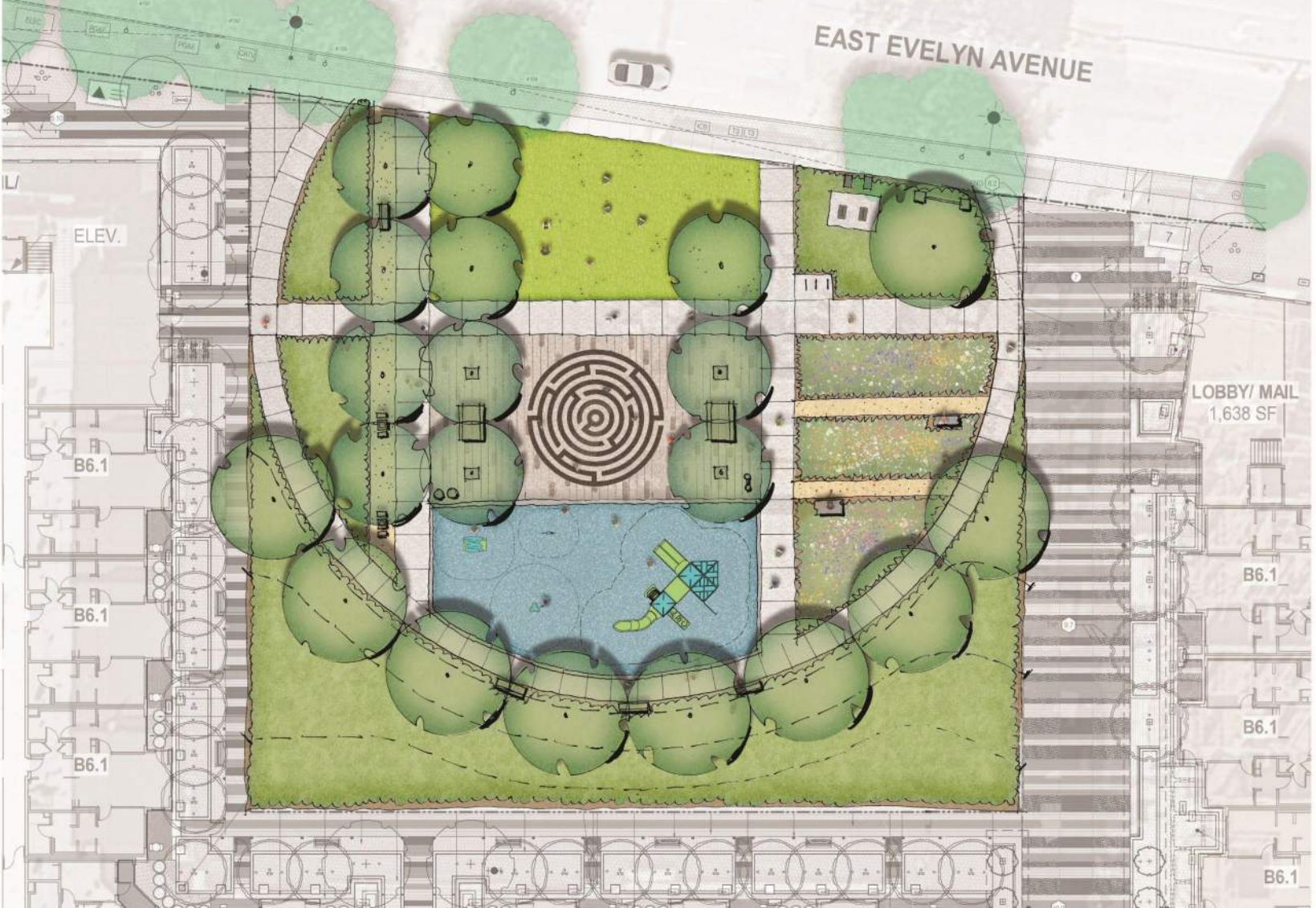

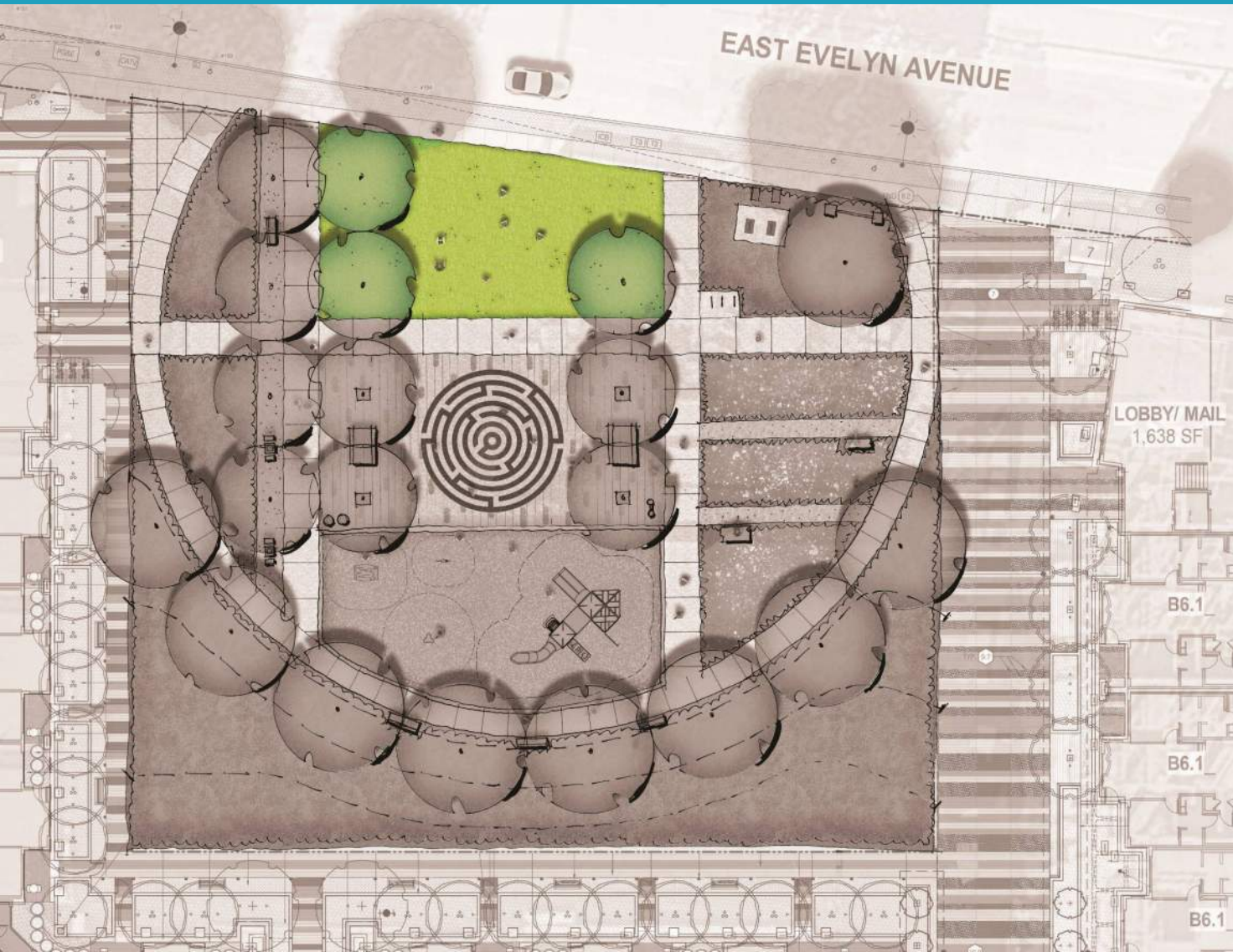

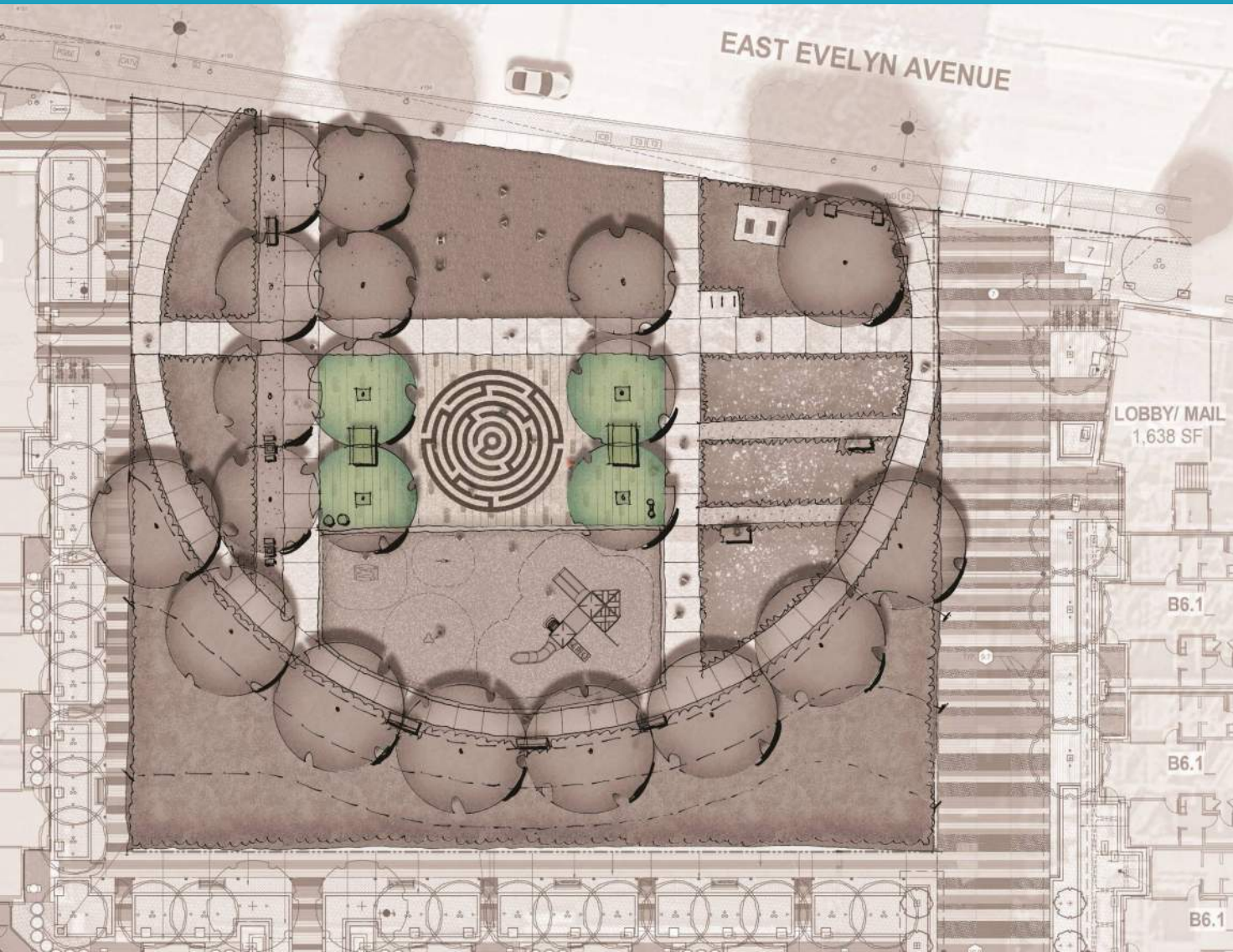

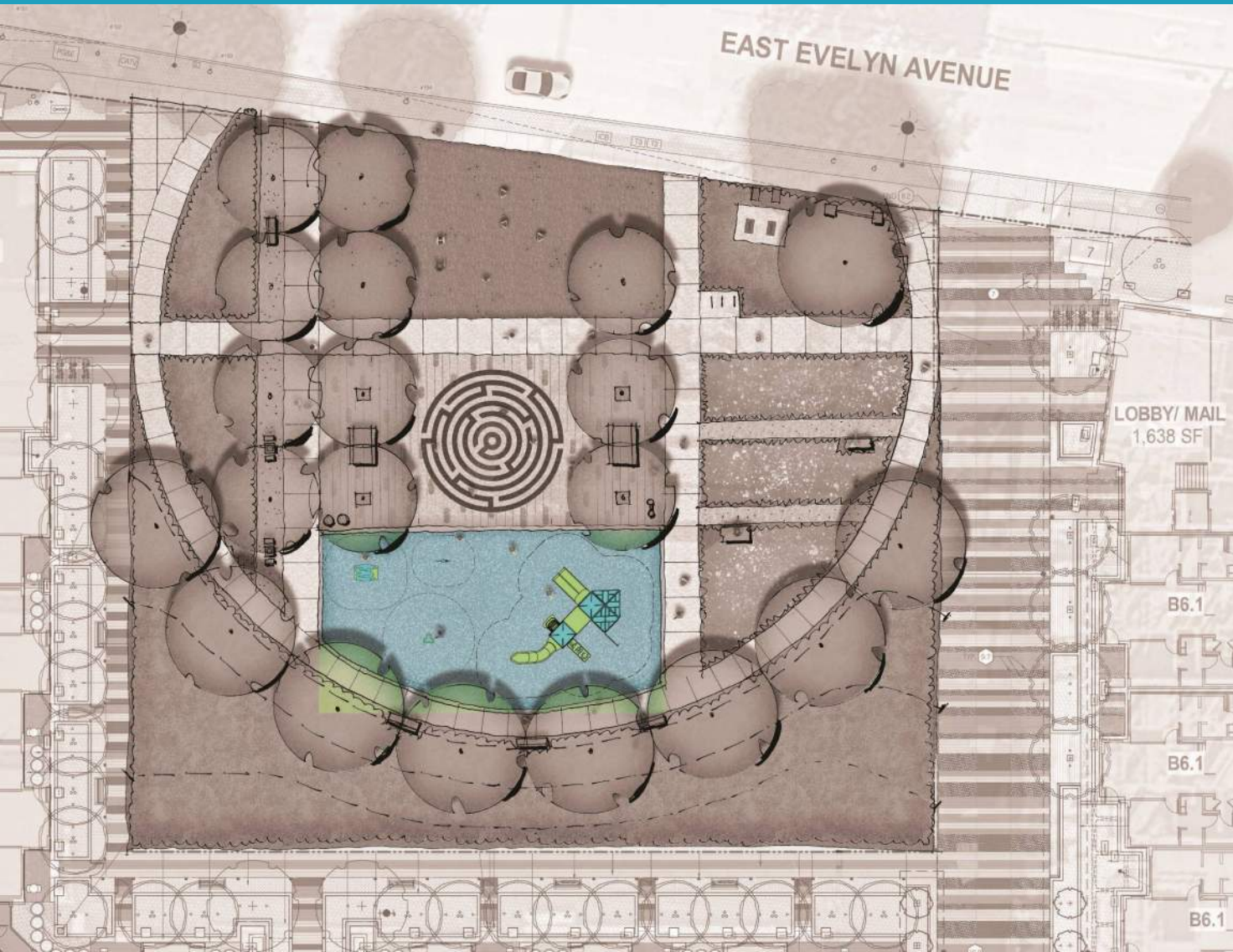

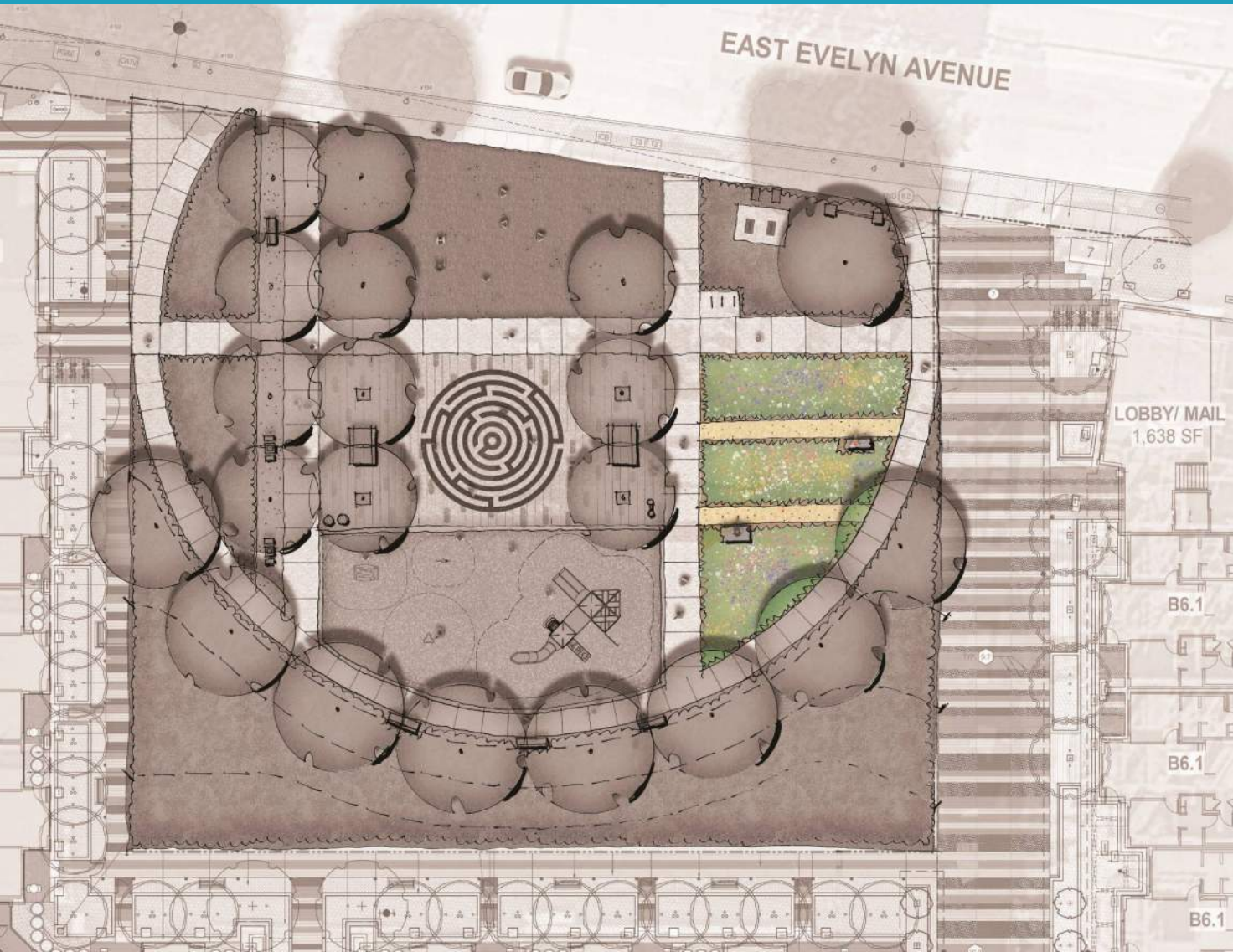

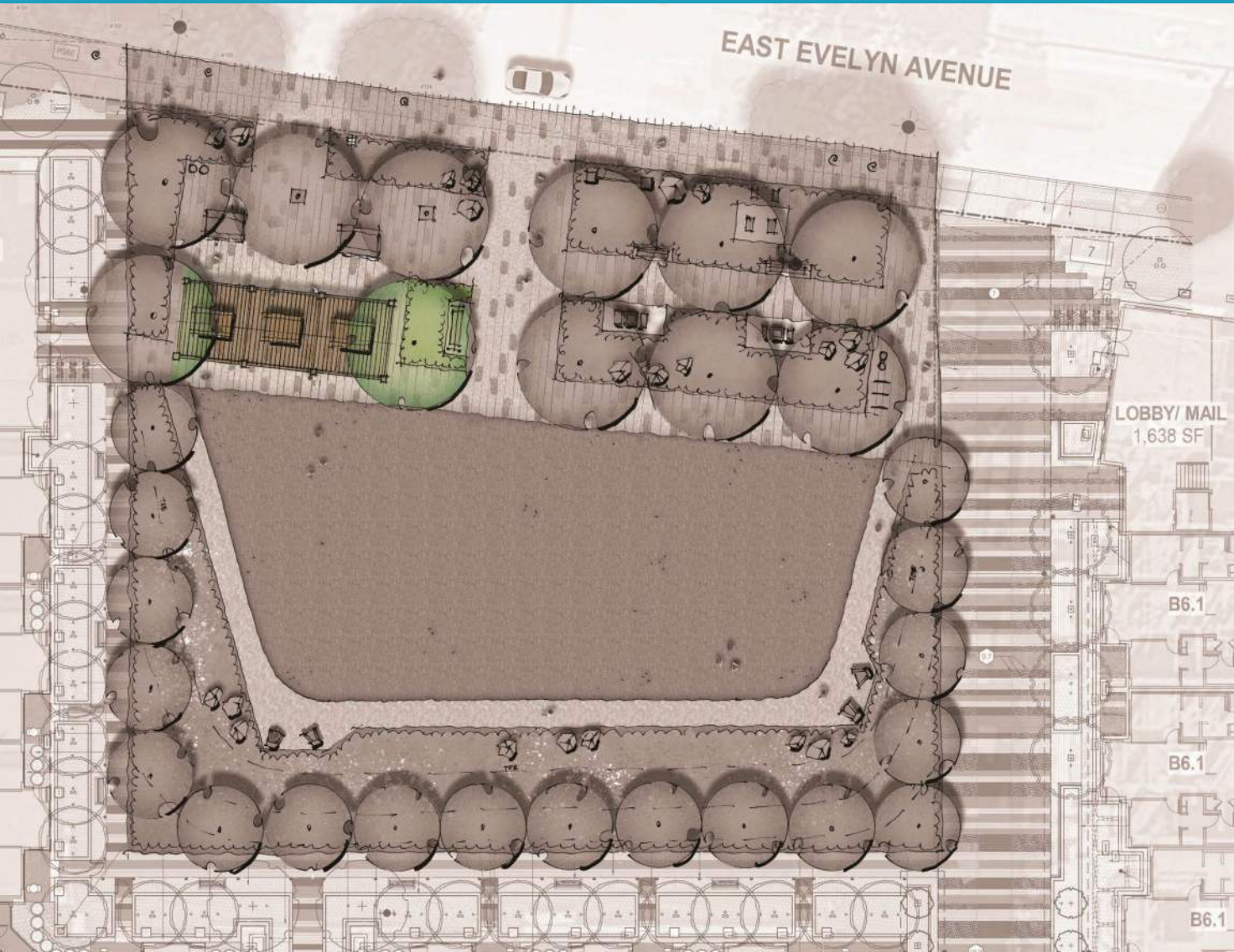

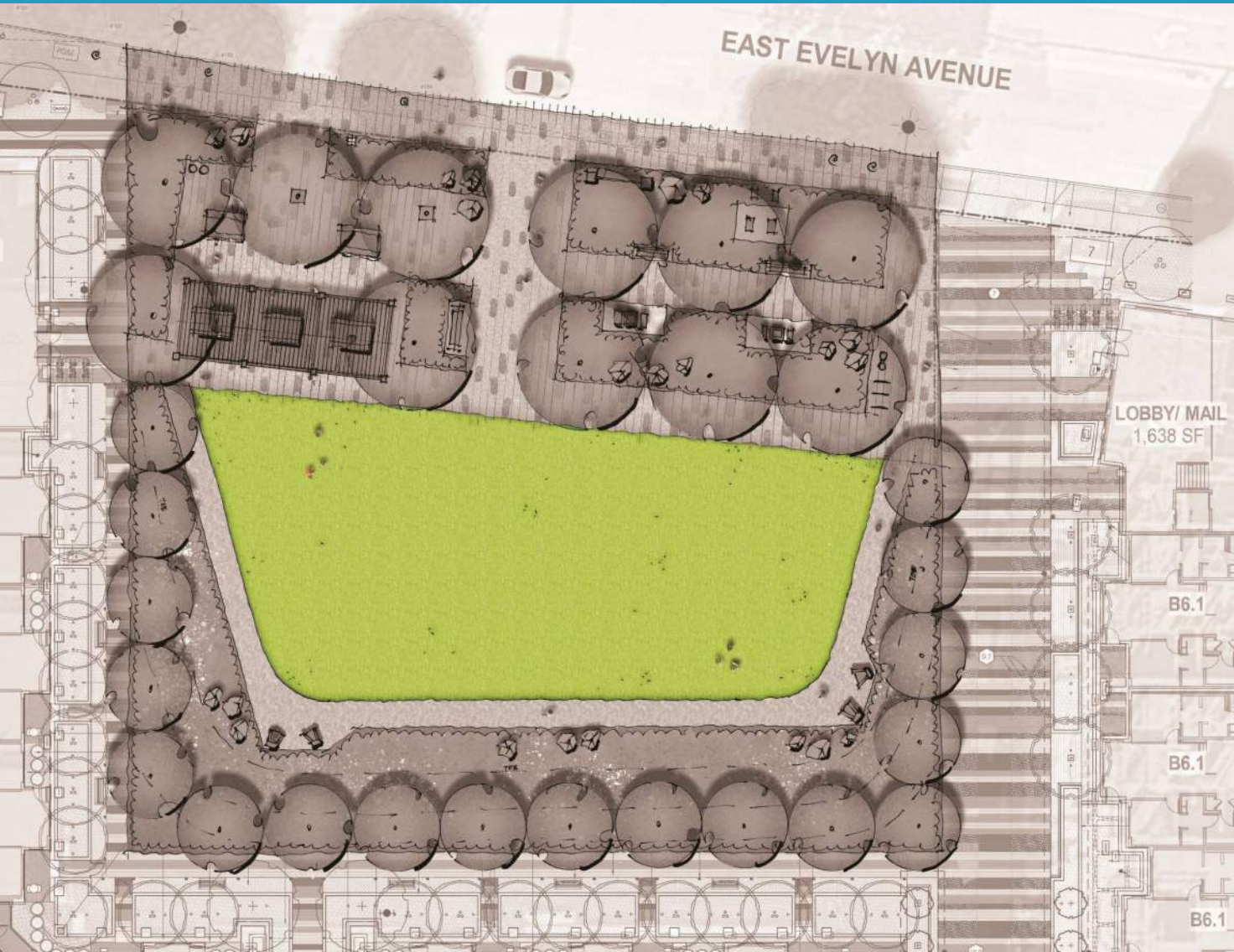

Process

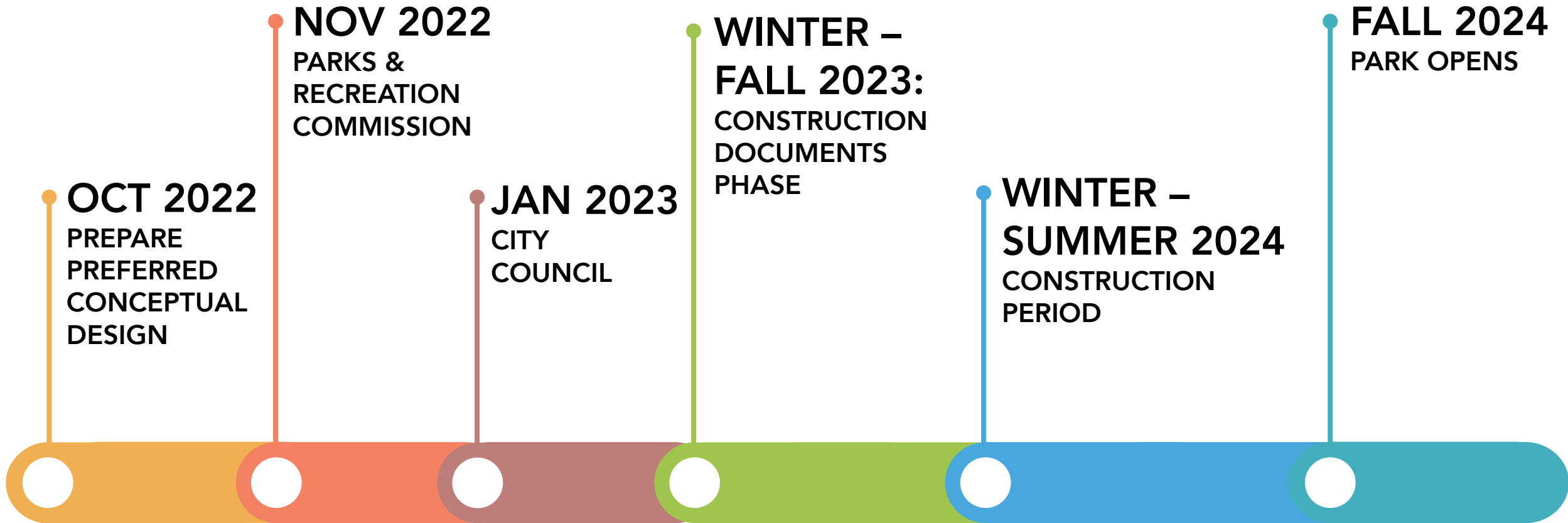
- Community Participation
